

Turn your story into real-world impact.

- Authors and publishers donate 5–30 copies of a children's book and sponsor one or more schools in Sierra Leone.
- Develop Africa places your books in classrooms, documents the impact with photos and videos, and—by tier—provides backpacks and tuition support to children.
- We handle shipping, coordination, delivery, and storytelling.

Why This Program Matters

Many schools in Sierra Leone lack age-appropriate books and basic school supplies. Your partnership places real stories into real classrooms, strengthens early literacy and confidence, equips children with backpacks (by tier), and helps keep at least one child in school through tuition support while giving you authentic impact content to share.



How It Works

1. [Submit your book for review](#) (age & cultural fit)
2. If approved, ship copies to our Tennessee office and complete payment
3. We deliver to schools in Sierra Leone (and backpacks/tuition where applicable)
4. We share photos and videos of children using your book

Partnership Levels (Per School)

- \$400 Starter Impact: Books + 20-30 photos (no backpacks, no tuition)
- \$800 Bronze: Adds video + 1 backpack + 1 tuition
- \$1,200 Silver: Adds student reflection video + 1 backpack + 1 tuition (Total 2/2)
- \$1,700 Gold: Adds another student reflection video + 1 backpack + 1 tuition (Total 3/3)
- \$2,450 Platinum: Adds teacher impact video, extra student reflection, program credit, feature page, certificate + mini report, newsletter spotlight, +1 backpack + 1 tuition (Total 4/4)

Optional Upgrades

- Adopt-a-Classroom Backpack Kit (30 students): \$1,800
- Virtual Classroom Visit (Gold/Platinum): \$1,000

Important: Partnership fees are not tax-deductible (service-based partnership). Capacity is limited each quarter; applications may be waitlisted for the next cohort.




